Welcome to the Little Chargers Preschool Program!

SCHEDULE: There will be a Monday/Tuesday/Thursday (full days) session, and a Wednesday/Friday (full days) session. Students that are 4 and 5 years of age would come on the M/T/TH days and student that are 3 years old will attend on the W/F days.

TUITION: Tuition for the Little Chargers 3-day session is \$700 per year and \$500 per year for the 2-day session.

TRANSPORTATION: All Little Chargers will be able to be picked up on the regular bus route in the mornings. Westbrook students would then ride the appropriate shuttle bus to and from Walnut Grove. Students will then return home on the regular routes in the afternoon. We will again create a laminated student identity sheet that will remain in each student's back pack with a student picture with mom and dad's names, phone numbers to call, etc. This has worked very well in the past.

BREAKFAST/DINNER: Preschool – 6th grade students receive free breakfast regardless of family income. This means all Little Chargers will be able to eat breakfast for free at school. Westbrook and Walnut Grove students would eat breakfast together once the shuttle arrives in Walnut Grove. At this time the cost for a school lunch is \$2.25/per student, preschool thru 6th grade. Payments can and should be made monthly. Monthly payments run at around \$45.00 for full paying students. All parents will be required to fill out a free/reduced lunch application. Those that qualify for free or reduced lunches will be notified via the District Office. Please call Eileen Helmer in the Walnut Grove office if you have any questions about your lunch bill.

LIBRARY: The Little Chargers visit the school library weekly and are allowed to check out books. Please remember to send those books back to school with them on Tuesday/Wednesday of the next week, depending on their class session day.

NAPS: Little Chargers will have a daily naptime. Each student is required to bring his/her own sleeping mat or rug.

SUPPLIES: WWG School will provide the supplies needed for preschool. Students should provide their own backpacks to take their projects home in. The Walnut Grove office has extra backpacks if you need one.
